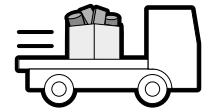
Booking a hazardous waste disposal service

Canford Recycling Centre is a licensed disposal facility that is able to accept a large array of hazardous and difficult wastes, some of which are detailed in the following section.

i *Hazardous wastes always require a consignment note to be completed and must be pre-booked prior to tipping at Canford Recycling Centre.*

The individual or business that holds / stores the waste

The appointed (licensed) individual or business that collects and transports the waste
